



Recently I have played with members who have not always found it necessary to mark their balls on the putting green. Remember, when putting in stroke play, if your ball strikes another ball on the putting surface, you incur a 2 stroke penalty. Therefore, it is a courtesy to your playing partners to always mark your ball. Here is the rule for your review.

RULE 19 BALL IN MOTION DEFLECTED OR STOPPED

19-5 By Another Ball

a. At Rest

If a player's ball in motion after a stroke is deflected or stopped by a ball in play and at rest, the player must play his ball as it lies. In match play, there is no penalty. In stroke play, there is no penalty, unless both balls lay on the putting green prior to the stroke, in which case *the player incurs a penalty of two strokes*.
